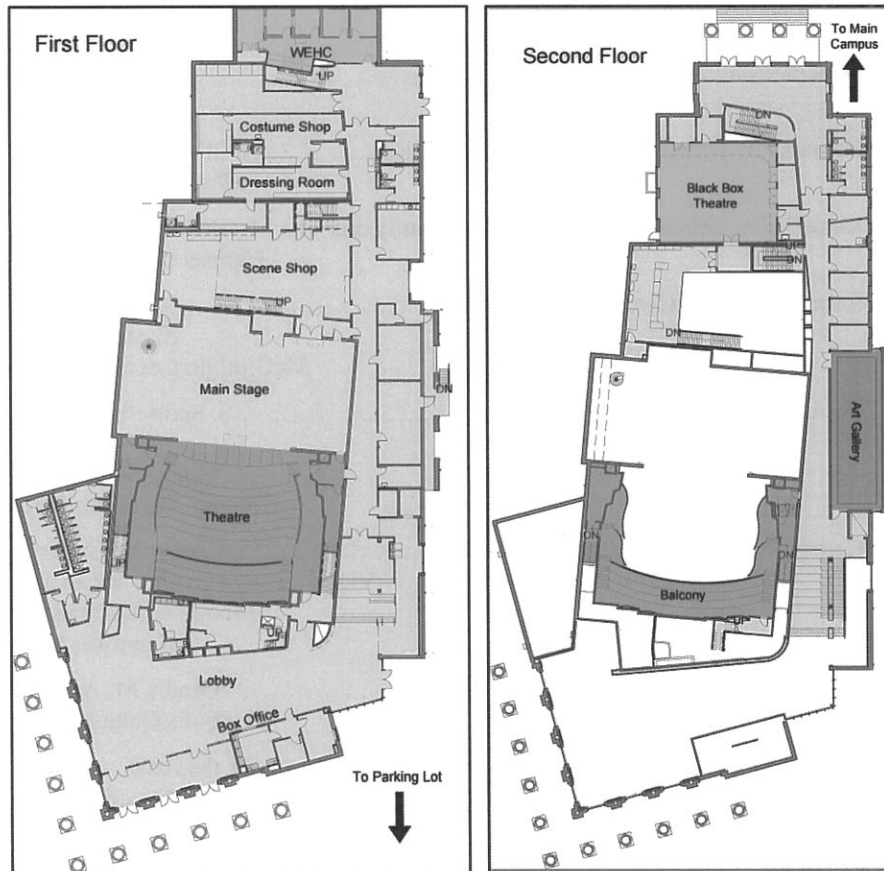

The Woodrow W. McGlothlin Center for the Arts honors the memory of a successful native of Buchanan County, Virginia and 1937 graduate of Emory & Henry College, who, as one of the founders of The United Company and long-time member of the College's Board of Visitors, became one of the College's all-time greatest benefactors. Mr. McGlothlin passed away in 2005, and his sons, Jim, Tom '68, and Mickey McGlothlin, along with The McGlothlin Foundation, continued his legacy of generosity to Emory & Henry by contributing funds to help construct this new center for the arts on the campus. The College's Board of Trustees voted in 2010 to name this center in memory of Woodrow W. McGlothlin, the construction of which began in 2013 and ended in 2015.

The Woodrow W. McGlothlin Center for Arts on the main campus of Emory & Henry College is a \$22 million, 47,367-square-foot state-of-the-art facility designed for LEED silver energy efficiency standards. It consists of a 461-seat proscenium stage theatre and fly system, a 120-seat black box studio theatre, dressing rooms, production areas, a modern art gallery, offices for theatre department faculty members and staff, and studios for the campus and community radio station, WEHC 90.7 FM.
